ACTION1. Relocation of Site Personnel

Proctor indicated need for scheduling the relocation of site personnel.

2. McGuire

Brown requested briefing on Lincoln activity assisting in McGuire implementation. Rich reviewed results of discussion and meetings involving Western Electric, IBM, BTL, Air Force, SDC, and Lincoln Personnel.

A meeting is scheduled in New York 13 May in which Ed Rich will review program changes and other items arranged in order of priority. Brown who has been out of town, will participate.

3. Model III Shakedown

Brown reported desire on the part of SDC Program Development Group to obtain XD-1 time around 1 June for assembly testing the Model III program.

Brown has asked Rich to designate Buzzard to coordinate Lincoln assistance to SDC on this item.

4. Laboratory Visitors

Farr reviewed tentative agenda of briefings for visitors, (Advanced Research Project Agency 13 May, and SHAPE 15 May).

5. XD-1 Time Allocation

Fallows announced a meeting for later in the week to discuss time allocation to XD-1 users. Brown urged the inclusion of an SDC representative in the meeting.

Everett requested Fallows to present a summary of problems, if any, remaining after the meeting.

6. MTC

Daggett proposed release of MTC to Group 62. O'Brien indicated need for certain MTC components for the ALRI bread-board unit -- O'Brien also outlined a plan for release of MTC components to other groups in exchange for technician assistance.

Everett approved the release of MTC to Group 62.
