## Outline, orientation study:

- 1. Survey of orientation features of Boston (peninsula within Dover & Berkeley sts.), as noted from foot, car, subway.
- 2. Ask simple directions on street, & record.
- 3. For a prepared set of more complex directions:
  - ✓ a. make introspective analysis of the process of moving through.
    - b. move through on ground & note the clues.
    - c. ask a selected few to give such directions,
       & then to describe process of mental construction.
- 4. Have number of people draw sketch map of this area.

## Go from:

- 1. City Hall to Old North Church.
- 2. Custom House Tower to Music Oval.
- 3. Charles River Dam Circle to South Station.
- 4. Park Square Bus Terminals
  To Haymarket Circle
- 5. Elevated Station Dover & Washington to State House

Ask a few people to describe these routes, by car & by public transportation. Then to describe as best they can the mental process they went through. Also to do the same for a very familiar route.
