1. JSAC Preparation

Forrester outlined the program for Lincoln Laboratory budget presentation to the JSAC on January tenth.

Farr is coordinating the preparation of the tabulation of Lincoln tasks; Forrester will need additional material for the oral portion of the presentation.

3. SAGE Improvement Committee

Everett reported on a recent committee meeting and outlined the problem of meeting the need for full-time staff members to be assigned to SAGE Improvement studies.

4. General Smith's Visit

General Smith's visit is scheduled for January fourth.

5. Press Visitors

Taylor brought up the question of the visit of press representatives scheduled for January sixteenth. Visitors will represent Associated Press and TIME-LIFE; the visit will coincide approximately with the release of the COLLIER'S article. Clarification of security regulations concerning Building F are needed from the LPO.

6. Weapons Integration

Israel stated that Boeing representatives are here this week and next to finish writing their report.

7. IBM Building Space

Forrester quoted Mills of IBM, who announced December thirtieth approval received for the provision of an IBM building to be erected at Lexington.

8. Meetings this Week

A review of the meeting schedule indicated the IBM Coordination Meeting on January fourth was canceled; meeting with Wilkes of ADES in New York on January fourth to be attended by Israel, Jacobs, and McVicar; pre-ADES Meeting at Lincoln on January fifth, ADES Meeting at New York on January tenth (conflicts with JSAC).
