They desire to limit the cost of windows to 10,000, or at the most \$12,000, preferably the lower figure.

No definite suggestions regarding the subjects, except the Baptist of Christ was mentioned for the large window on the west, or possibly for the middle parts of this window, the Committee being desirous of obtaining suggestions from the designers. Make subjects appropriate for a Baptist Church.

Antique glass desired.

December 3rd Letter

1. The large west window of church facing on Amsterdam Avenue, a wide street.
2. Three side windows of church, facing north on 92nd Street, 60 feet wide.
3. Three side windows opposite the above facing South on a passage about 12' 0" wide between the church property and that adjoining.
4. Two large windows on 92nd street lighting Sunday school ~~room~~
5. One window adjoining these over the Sunday School ~~room~~ ^{entrance}

Notice that the side windows of the church are unfortunately interrupted by a gallery.

Material of the interior surface of church will be so-called "Caen Stone Keystone", a rough paint imitating Caen Stone. Woodwork of oak, not far from natural color, but a little darker.

Large west window be treated as principal feature
