



 Divided into 3 panels with 3 figures.



If a frame of  
 the same thickness  
 as that of the next  
 window be substituted  
 for the existing one,  
 which is part of  
 the tracery, the  
 size of your opening  
 from the back of  
 the rebate is  
 $66\frac{3}{4} \times 100\frac{3}{4}$ . The  
 top is a true semi-  
 circle. The rebate  
 is  $\frac{1}{2}$ " deep. The  
 size shown for  
 the ventilator  
 is taken from the  
 centers of the  
 webs of the Truss.

For the figure of Faith the words. "This is Our Victory, <sup>Our</sup> Faith"

For Hope "Happy is He whose Hope is in the Lord"

For Love, the central figure "He <sup>that</sup> ~~Who~~ Loves <sup>the</sup> Not, Knows <sup>the</sup> not God,  
for God is Love"

At the base of the centre panel occur the words.

"And now Abide with Faith, Hope, and Love  
These three, and the Greatest of these is Love"

Contract made out as follows:

25% when design is accepted

20% " window half finished

35% when window completed in shop.

Mr Houghton writes that the arches of masonry  
opening are not vertical, spreading apart  
from opening line to sill. ~~Mr~~

Bottom ornament to be placed in middle  
base of the window.

like spindles and needles, while same  
effect in the original design is shorter  
and much more handsome

The feet of the centre figure looks like  
feet of a claw foot table, while originally  
she wore sandals

Original Design The angels were in profile  
Do not like angels with two wings
