From Mr. Connick's Letter.

"My idea is to have ^{for} the background of the figures light suggestions of various forms of the Cross, traced and lightly stained -- perhaps for "Faith" (see letter in file) and for "Hope" (also see letter) and for "Love" (also see letter). Talk it over with Troto and others.

Troto will get my idea of the canopy I think. It is to be of light golds and stained whites, and is to be done with "careless care", and all that sort of thing.

Don't be confused by these comments.- they have to do with the cartoons, especially -- and glass also.
