* Light is more brilliant in the West than in the East on account of the higher altitude of the sun and clearness of the air.
 Interior of the church to be finished in hand trowelled plaster of a somewhat brownish color, rather light brown more like a warm gray. The roof trusses are adzed and stained brown; fixtures wrought iron; woodwork around the chancel rough hewn oak stained brown.

It is possible that you could suggest some inscription suitable for St. Michael and St. Gabriel. Also, if you find that the scripture references do not fit in well with the design they could be omitted. It is desired that the type of lettering used should be reasonably legible, possibly an uncial or a form of Old English more legible than the usual lettering.
