General Information This Crypt contains twenty-four small windows in groups of two. Three groups of two are behind the Altar. Five groups on the East and four on the West. These windows are very small and I have suggested enriching only half of them with suitable symbols.

Archbishop Dowling has agreed to this and will send us the list of twelve saints to be represented by symbolic heraldry like those in the Church of St. John the Evangelist.

These are to be in simple oblongs in tints of white glass with a colored border, and are to be placed in heavy lead. They are also to be sufficiently obscure so that they cannot be seen through at night.

The interior of this chapel is to be interesting but somewhat rugged with a good deal of brick work showing. The leads should have a certain freedom, and the windows should avoid all mechanical appearances.

These windows, like those in the Convent Chapel are to be five dollars per foot all over. No contracts have been made for either of these chapels.
