General Information Vestry considering two chancel windows (9 feet x 2 Ft.)
and possibly a central window formally in memory of Dr. James Buck.
Opposite the central one on west side to be given by Miss Bigelow.
Two chancel windows one on either side or reredos which closes the
central one of a group of three are to be very simple, grisaille,
with designs of cartouches or other symbols to be left to your
judgment.

Prevailing effect of interior decoration will be white as the
church is to be restored in colonial style. The floor being a composition
covered with gray dill walls not yet decided upon. Chancel floor
tyled in terra cotta.
