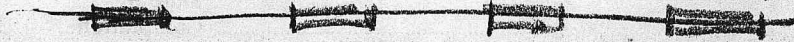
General Information "Christ the Friend of Men and Women"

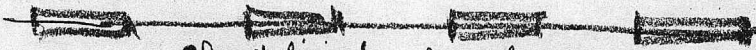

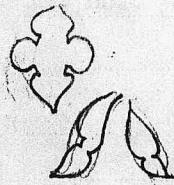

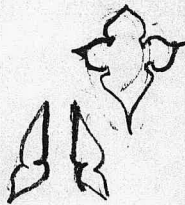
