General Information Quatrefoils and triangular shapes on either side of the main entrance. "I have kept in mind your idea of color ranging from gold through ruby to blue, and have suggested an arrangement in harmony with the rose window over the altar. I think that the space calls for some definite form, and I have suggested an ornamental cross as principal motif.

The twelve kites for the transom over the main entrance door, are actual openings in the stone itself, the raglet following the profile of the design as shown. These are separate openings, making twelve separate pieces of glass in all.
