"When the new window is placed, the changes planned are simply those involved in setting that window. That is the D'Ascenzo window to go nearest the gallery while the Davidson window is to replace the D'Ascenzo window. The other changes will come later. Dr. Kirk wants me to proceed if I have opportunity with the great front window, the Tree of Jesse."

"The Davison window to be placed on the east side, in place of the present D'Ascenzo window, which in turn will be placed at the extreme south end of the church on same side, cost of same to be born by the Church."

Dr. Kirk's note - "The new Gildersleeve window to be installed with iron work etc, as part of the contract with Mrs. Lane."
