light and installation complete. These are to be done in French grisaille
type, with Louis XVI ornaments painted and stained.
Not over 3/8" leads in Dining Room Window. Keep Ventilator
bar in skylight as narrow as possible. Wood like straw tints in the
background. Stain kept rich gold with a touch of lemon gold—Ornament
not to be too dry and wiry, but given here and there the freedom of
handling.
