General Information "All Saints" Three figures in each section, making 24 in all which represents four and twenty elders at the throne of God. The central figure surrounded by seven doves, - the seven gifts of the Spirit. Emblems of four Evangelists forming a cross interchanged with four adoring angels, some with musical instruments.

The Saints which Mr. Connick has suggested are as follows: at the top, Saint John the Baptist, Blessed Virgin Mary, and Saint Elizabeth, next, to the right, Saint Joan of Arc, Saint George, Saint Martin of Tours, and following around in their proper order, - Saint Dominic, Saint Peter, and Saint Benedict, Elijah, Isaiah and Daniel, David, Jesse, Abraham, Moses, Joshua, and Gideon, Saint Augustine, Saint Paul, Saint Jerome, Saint Anthony of Padua, Francis and Saint Cecilia.
