General Information 7 aisle windows, large window in west elevation, smaller windows over each side door, and 2 vestibule windows.

Mr. Parker of Sturgis' office asked O.E.S. about enriching the window over the entrance, to get in more color and darken it, and we suggested about 5 medallions in each panel (15 in all), and we thought that an additional cost might be about \$500. If ventilators were used in any of the windows, they might cost between \$12. and \$15.
