General Information Small scale sketch using two shields which Mr. Whittier left here on April 8th. A simple leaded pattern.

2 shields with the crests. This field might be of clear glass, or interesting tints of nearly clear antique could be introduced to excellent purpose.

We would suggest a good rugged lead at least half an inch wide, glazed in a slightly irregular fashion; that is, just enough to avoid a mechanical appearance.
