An alternate background to be used from the one now in place.

"Saint Peter is represented in the first panel with his symbols, the book and key. The keys - gold and silver - reoccur as a symbol below. The companion figure represents Saint Paul holding the sword as symbol. At his feet occur the conventionalized fountains - another traditional symbol of Saint Paul. The tracery contains seven flames, symbols of Divine Zeal, occupying the position of the seven stars in the other window. And in the quatrefoil the monogram X.P. in place of the I.H.C. in the previous window. Historical forms of the Cross and Christ's monogram could be continued in the remaining windows. . . . "In Memory of" and "And" are placed in the grisaille field in order to balance the text so that it will appear to good advantage in the design."
