General Information "A grisaille pattern of the type for which you have indicated a preference, with the foliated cross in one of the circle units. (Detroit, North Woodward M.E. Church, Grisaille). Place the cross in the upper unit. Use pure colors, but they should not be vivid or glaring. The pure color would be in small spots and straps against a field of light silvery tints."

~~If we supply a new frame it will probably be about \$10.00 extra. They will pay ten or fifteen dollars extra for the vent.~~

Mar. 5. - Miss Lockwood wrote - "The colors might be subdued a bit." C.J.C. replied. "I am reluctant to subdue the colors very much, for I am confident that when you see the actual window in color and light, that you will feel the essential quality of the small bits of pure color, etc. I shall reduce the pure color areas as much as possible."
