General Information "For the side sanctuary windows I have suggested a design which will be in harmony with both the temporary glass and the permanent windows. One of these would be devoted to the New Testament with the Four Evangelists with Angels of Praise and Prayer, as indicated on the cover sheet; and the other would stand for the Old Testament with the four Prophets and their symbols. The vine pattern would beautifully enrich the field. A very much simpler alternative suggestion would involve a field similar to the design of the nave windows, enriched with symbols of the Four Evangelists, two in each group. "
