\*\*"...I am considering having new sash made where the top part would be stationary and approximately 5' of the bottom would be used for ventilating purposes." Mr. Koch.

Description of sketch: "An angel of prayer, holding the symbol of prayer, a censer, is placed at the top of the design. The angel's robes are white, symbolizing faith and purity. The wings are blue, color of divine wisdom and truth, and gold, the color of spiritual victory. This color appears also in the nimbus, censer, and the border which surrounds the grisaille pattern of the background.

Here the gold enriches a significant grape vine motif which symbolizes the growth and fruitfulness of the Word of God.

The color symbolism is completed by the accents of red in the background, the color of divine love and compassion."
