General Information "The large west window might be the Benedicite, because the
reredos, although it has only three figures, has an inscription from the Te
Deum. And my idea would be to carry out the Te Deum idea in the painted
panels of the reredos, for which I shall make a design. . . . What I
think ought to be done very soon is a series of designs made for him. Not
too much time on them, but still make them good." (C.J.C.'s report of May 19,

Notes on Providence Benedicite window.

The design should be developed with less rigid angles in the medallions shapes and a more interesting link ~~between~~ between them. Background areas of blue may well be increased in center medallions and the reds lessened somewhat.

In the upright tracery pieces the medallion-like shapes should be more sympathetic with shapes of tracery pieces.
