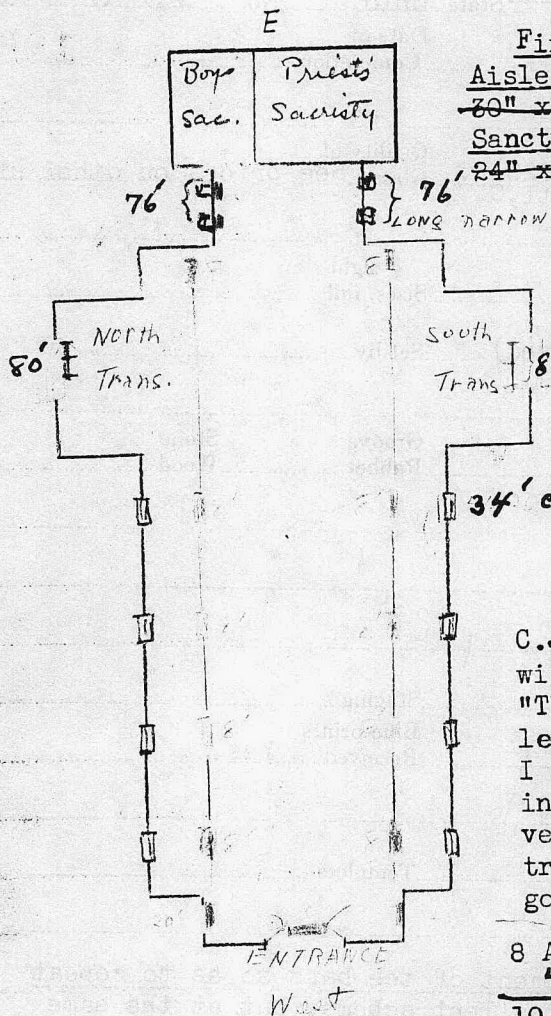

General Information Q.J.C. said, "Your arrangement of tee-bars so as to repeat the height of the ventilators, is an excellent scheme, but at the same time the upper ventilators will have a tendency to determine the scale of the design. Possibly it is your intention to use a medallion type of design; but if it were not for those ventilators, I should visualize standing figures at the heads of the windows, with a distinguishing medallion - or two medallions underneath."

Mr. Schulte said, "The church has a rather fresh flavor, and the entire interior will be lined with a very deep buff sandstone, carrying a rust color figure through it. It is our intention to paint the roof a whitish grey, on which will be applied ornament in blue, brown and some pink. This color scheme we hope to reproduce more or less in the floor. I should like very much to have the windows correspond in character to the
