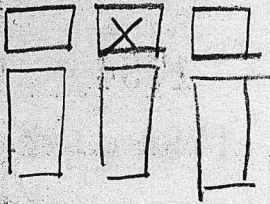

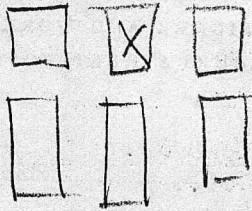

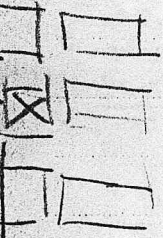
Fountain
