General Information Possibly related to the Psalms may be the 23rd Psalm.

"Being on the north, I think it would be a good idea to have a subject related to the Old Testament, as the south transept is now given over to Apostolic and Post Apostolic figures. I also thought that the angel window (evidently St. Gabriel) underneath this two lancet tracery window and the small figure of the boy Christ as a Pilgrim should be taken into account.

Window to be largely "floral" grisaille - flowing form of growth enriched with symbols of 23rd Psalm. "Surely Goodness and Mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the House of the Lord forever."
