This window is designed to celebrate confidence in the grace of God as set forth in David's Twenty-third Psalm. The text is taken from the first verse, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."

The dominant medallion symbolizing Christ the Good Shepherd, guarding His sheep, is surrounded by growing vine ~~branches~~ flowering in white fleur-de-lis of purity as in the other panels.

Above is the Archangel Uriel - Regent of the Sun and teacher of Eudras. He is accompanied by children with trumpets symbolizing praise of the Lord.

A pleasant counterchange of color is suggested in the blue borders and fields, contrasting to excellent purpose with the central color scheme predominantly ruby.

A space for the memorial inscription is designed at the base.
