General Information Repair broken glass in the church.

Directions to Church - Take Huntington Avenue Car to Brookline Village - Harvard Avenue car toward Allston - get off at Aspinwall - just a few blocks ride.

"The Vestry have authorized us to repair the 3 broken pieces in the church windows at a cost of about \$20 or \$25. 2 of the broken pieces are in the chancel windows and 1 in one of the windows at the west end of the church. The chancel windows are protected by iron screens on the outside and are covered by an ornamental wooden screen on the inside. The iron screens will have to be taken down to get at the windows. Church will furnish the ladder. The Sexton is Mr. Montgomery."
