"The sturdy figure is kept well within the scale of the window itself, the point of the window being occupied with the crown, significant that, even as a boy, David was crowned King by the Prophet Samuel.

The growing form throughout the background, and the nine small pomegranates, are gentle symbols of St.Paul's significant expression to the Galatians: "But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance, against such there is no law." (Galatians 5:22,23). Also is featured the text from II Timothy 1:7, "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."

Note: Let Mrs. Weld know when window is in glass, so she can bring down the students.

Also they will bring down the sash when the window is finished, so we can put the glass in it and send it back by express, and we will not have to send our man there. Ship back the sash with the Peterboro glass at the same time.
