General Information New heads for the 2 center chancel windows.

Autumn, 1944. C.J.C. reported on his return from San Francisco: "The heads are way too dark, - the present heads. Huneke is sending them back (received here), and he is sending a little piece of glass approximately the same tint as the heads in place. He had a swinging scaffolding. He couldn't get them in because the leads aren't good - the heads have been changed twice already."

"I suggested to the Bishop that when we set those four windows (the next two aisle and two chancel), that it would be a good thing if we could manage it to set them at the same time, and have a real substantial scaffolding, and take out more of the glass in the region of the heads, so that we will tackle fresh lead instead of those now there."

"make heads in one piece, and get same effect. The hands are quite light, and they must be matched."
