General Information Notes when sketches sent: "A typical sketch represents one group of Sacristy windows, designed for a very simple pattern of light tinted but beautifully selected glasses, with a pure blue border accented with touches of gold and ruby and symbols of the Prophets and Evangelists. The kneeling Prophets bear scrolls inscribed with their names, and the Evangelists are identified by their usual signs: The Winged Man - for St. Matthew, the Lion - Saint Mark, the Ox - St. Luke, and the Eagle for St. John. In this sketch, I have suggested the Prophets Isaiah and Jeremish, and the Evangelists, St. Matthew and St. Mark, with a similar arrangement in mind for the other group of openings."
