General Information It is a strange Greek sort of Church (See C.J.C.'s pencil  
suggestion on envelope. \$1000 scheme. My idea was just to have a little  
Annunciation - Cameo sort of thing - with little touches of gold, orange,  
white and blue. Lot of light in it - quite severe Greek business in  
border - white figures on blue ground in Annunciation medallion. Make a  
beautiful thing of it. Then to carry out the Mysteries of the Rosary  
through the aisle windows. This Annunciation window is in a kind of a  
transept. He has money for this (\$1000 - 50 feet), and also has money  
for Baptistry - three little windows. He said he had about \$1000 for it,  
but I said it is not enough - have to be at least \$200 or \$250.00.

Transept Window - 50 square feet. Exposure North.  $5\frac{1}{2}$  feet from floor - \$1000 -  
(\$20 per foot). Bottom vent, in place.  
Aisle Windows - Footage 32 square feet - 4 north, 4 south,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  feet from floor -  
\*\$650. each - \$20.00 per foot. Bottom vents, in place.  
Baptistry, 3 openings - Footage  $10\frac{1}{2}$  square feet - South. 11 feet from floor -  
\$250.00 \$24. per foot.  
Clerestory - (12) - 8 square feet each - 6 north, 6 south, 22 feet from floor -  
\* \$150. each - \$18. per foot.
