General Information Oct. 16, 1940. Sent 2 suggestions: A suggested Colonial lead ornaments at numerous points, thus adding an interesting note to the leaded surface pattern. We have in mind various rough textured glasses which will somewhat obscure the view without detracting from the light value of the fan.
B, is perhaps more modern in feeling, but still entirely appropriate. It involves a decorative use of the Greek cross through the central and surrounding circles. Again we would use the interesting textured patterns which give a sparkling glassiness to designs of this nature.
