As you will see, the design is very simple, depending for its effectiveness upon a very carefully thought out and well balanced arrangement of rhythmatic lead lines and spaces.

The fields are plenned in varying tints of light glass, their careful selection and balance producing a harmonious and interesting field.

The pure color notes of the border and accents in the field would alternate throughout the plan as indicated in the second sketch for the single mindow enriched with the engle symbol of Saint John the Evangelists

This alternation of color* will add interest and variety to the group.
