I have made the price per foot a little over \$38 with the thought that such  
window would gain in a nice proportion of exquisite medallion work for the  
subject, and rather simple ornamental work.

The donor has chosen these 3 windows because she has a great devotion to S  
Peter, and he appears in each of them.; 210 with the subject of St. John and  
Peter at the Tomb on Easter Morning. For reference see St. John's Gospel,  
Chapter 20, verses 3-9. Window 212 is to be The Call of St. John. That  
would normally include not St. Peter but St. James and Zebedee, the father of  
St. James and St. John, Cf St. Matthew Chapter 4 Verses 18-22, and St. Mark  
Chapter 1 Verses 16-20. As, however, the donor is giving these windows  
primarily out of a devotion to St. Peter she wants St. Peter included in  
each of these windows. ....You must therefore combine the Call of St.  
Peter, St. Andrew, St. James and St. John in one group as is often done in

Christian art, or we could take another scene that has to do with their Call as recorded in the Miraculous Draught of Fishes, Cf St. Luke Chapter 5 Verses 1-11, especially Verse 11 where four of these saints "forsook all and followed Him".

Window 211 is to be The Transfiguration. There is nothing difficult about getting both St. Peter and St. John in that window together with St. James. It will be good to work over these windows with you.
