Have at least one reinforcing bar to each panel. This could be applied in a
flat steel bar - set on edge - so that only a small section of it would
show, bent to roughly follow the lead lines, and soldered to the joints.
Numerous breaks should be covered with leadlines, and there are little
light leaks all through the panels where the glass does not fit the
lead. These should be covered with lead, etc.
