General Information Use same pattern as opposite window, with symbol of open Bible in the large center window.

This design is much in character with the east transept group, and the two windows in their varying lights will offer lovely contrasts in color and illumination in the ever changing mood of the weather. The dominant symbol of the open book is inscribed with the significant text from the last verse of Saint John's Revelations, "The grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all." As in the opposite window the rose and lily symbols alternate throughout the central medallion shapes and stars of divine steadfastness accent the border.

Note: Rev.Graepp wrote: "We want the West group to be very much in character with the East group in place, so that one group would not vary greatly in color, design and amount of light transmitted."
