General Information The general plan has been to gain added interest by the
alternation of the red and blue medallion fields, balancing them on the
opposite sides of the church. See floor plan, and photographs of windows
in place.

This window to be devoted to Christ the Light of the World - the Red scheme.
This is the last of the group - see photographs of others in place.

Related themes for the small medallions - the pillar of fire over the
Israelites, and the Star of Bethlehem, - also other parables such as the
Light under a bushel, one of the Wise Virgins with her lamp, or the woman with
the candle looking for her lost coin.

For addresses of those to be notified as window progresses, see other side.

We have completed our study of the design for your window devoted to Christ the Light of the World, and are sending the color sketch to you, herewith.

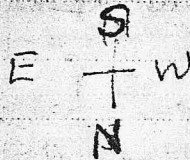
The figure of Our Lord holds the lighted lamp, the symbol of truth, learning, and enlightenment. Rays of divine light emanate from Him, spreading to all the world.

Small related symbols represent other guiding lights, - the Star of Bethlehem above, and below, the parables of the woman with the candle looking for her lost coin, and the light under a bushel.

The field is designed to harmonize with the other windows. At bottom use wording, Light of the World.

Be sure to use stars in the border, as we did in the other windows (omit the dice). Retain cruciform halo, but add more rays emanating from Our Lord at this point, ascension somewhat indicating a pointed halo.
