young Christ, with medallions below; - under David, the friendship of Jonathan
and David, and probably Christ in the Temple below the other.
Then the tracery would contain a symbol of God or Divine Grace.

Dr. Bosley liked the Kodachromes of the Ripley, Maplewood, and the David Window
in Holderness, and we sent these so he could show them to Mrs. Bosley.
