General Information This window will begin the East, or Old Testament display.  
Have this very much like the Prodigal Son window.  
It is to be Moses and the Decalog as the main medallion.  
Moses in the bulrushes, or some other fitting symbol is good for the  
subsidiary medallion.

Description of design: "Moses is represented bearing the Tablets of the Law.  
At either side are six-pointed stars of the Old Testament, and below is  
the symbol of the young child in the bulrushes."
