"Symbol of the Sower. The foliated field is pleasantly related to the other, with growing vine forms and acdents of stars. The central figure symbolizes the text:
"A sower went forth to sow his seed." At the left the figure stands in the barren rocky ground, surrounded by birds and thorns. Below is the inscription, "As he soweth some fell by the wayside." Opposite is the figure with his scythe amidst the plentiful harvest, with the text, "And other; fell on good ground and bare fruit." (from the Gospel of Saint Luke). "

BE SURE GLASS IS IN HARMONY WITH COMPANION WINDOW. Dr. Keller felt that the colors in the sketch are more pastel than those in the actual glass.
