General Information Symbol of Saint James Major. Scallop Shell and Pilgrim's
Staff. for Nave window, 5th from chancel (4th from organ).

"The dominant symbol is that of the Apostle, Saint James Major - scallop
shells and pilgrim's staff.

Refer to floor plan and photographs of windows now in place.

Note* There are vents in these windows. When our men set the glass, they can
either put cords on the vents, or seal them up - whichever the church
wishes - as we did in the case of the various other windows.

Nave window, last toward east, nearest entrance to bear traditional symbol of
St. Augustine - the flaming heart pierced with arrows - continuing the group of
Doctors of the Church, of which St. Gregory and St. Jerome are now symbolized
in the opposite windows. (See symbol of Philadelphia, St. Clement's Ch, S. Augustine)
