General Information To have a symbol of the Dove (principal symbol), with the lily in the border, and the anchor as a secondary symbol below.

Have lettering around or near the dominant symbol, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God."

We supply new wood frame (also vent). Frame is double-hung at present.

It is designed in harmony with our other windows in Saint Gabriel's Church, with foliated pattern and colorful interlacing strapwork supporting the dominant symbol of the Descending Dove of the Holy Spirit.

Through the field nearby is the significant text from the Beatitudes, "Blessed are the Pure in Heart, for they shall see God."

The anchor of Hope is introduced as a secondary symbol below, and the border is enriched with the lily of Purity.

Across the base is the memorial inscription, "To the Glory of God, and in loving memory of Beryl Keith Kane, 1865-1952."
