General Information

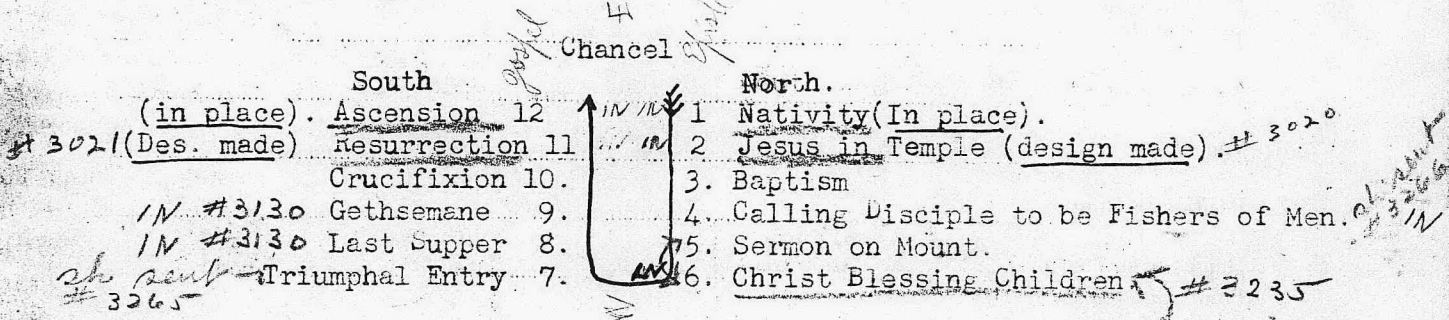
Church is of early Christian type architecture, and has 12 nave windows - two of which are now in place - see other side. Each window has a plain center panel, and it is this area that the stained glass memorial windows are to be inserted. See Kodachromes of the exterior of the church and the interior, showing the windows. Also see samples of glass in the windows now. Because of the existing glass in which these panels will be placed, medallions should be of light colored glass and simple in design, rather than the rich elaborate Gothic windows.

Subjects to be arranged to proceed from the chancel toward the back of Church.

8. The Last Supper.
9. Christ in the Garden.
10. The Crucifixion.
11. The Resurrection (design made #3021).
12. Ascension (in place).



We are to make designs for the remaining windows, with emphasis on "Christ Blessing Little Children" - which is wanted first.

We have completed our study for another of the panels for the Mount Baker Park Church, - the one devoted to Christ Blessing Children - and are sending it to you at once.

We think it presents a very happy arrangement, and we visualize how beautifully it will develop in the exquisite detail of line and form in the actual glass.

Last Supper " " " Last Supper is a community window, about 10 donors.

"Gethsemane" - The donors has expressed the hope that this window will have a little lighter blue in its upper part as compared with the sketch. She would prefer that it would shade into more of a topaz blue as she has seen in some of the churches in Europe.
