General Information Repair.

They are going to paint the interior of the Church in August, 1952, they think, and would like us to repair the windows then from the painter's scaffolding.

This will include the repairs to the old transept window opposite ours, using Jim's estimate of \$100.

Removing the two top sections of the central lancet, and putting in new lead or tee bar.

Replace the broken piece in the chancel window; put three new bars across the lower sections of our transept window - straighten the two sections a bit, if possible; and fill in a couple of holes in the tracery shape of one of the aisle windows with a little plastic wood or putty or something - just to keep out the weather.
