We have completed another color sketch for your side window series, and are sending it herewith.

This one is devoted to Saint John the Evangelist, who is represented at the center bearing the Chalice and serpent, recalling the legend of the poisoned draught which he drank without injury.

Below is his evangelical symbol, the eagle. At the left, he is represented as a young man making his evangelical record of the crucifixion; and, at the right, as an old man on the Isle of Patmos, recording his vision of the Church coming down from heaven adorned as a bride.
