General Information The Chapel is used every Sunday for small children. Windows are to have scenes from the Life of Christ: We have photographs of the exterior of the chapel, and one of the inside taken from a pamphlet. These are French windows, and will open inward. We want to introduce a more modern touch.

This window to be The Crucifixion and Resurrection.

The theme of the entire group of 3 windows is Christ's childhood, the Two Sacraments, and the Eternal Victory.

design for your final pair of windows devoted to the Eternal Victory, and are sending you the rough color sketch herewith.

At the left is the Crucifixion with Saint John the Beloved Disciple, and Mary the Mother, at the foot of the cross. The other two crosses are suggested in silhouette.

At the right is Our Lord rising from the dark tomb, bearing the cruciform banner of victory; with two sleeping soldiers below.

The memorial inscription is indicated across the base: "In Memory of Pleasant J. and May E. Mills."

We feel that this will beautifully complete the group of three, and we are eager to continue its development in the color and light of the actual glass.
