We feel we have succeeded in capturing in color and line something of the dramatic quality of the significant scene set forth in the early verses of the second chapter of The Acts, and all well within the somewhat formal idiom of our craft.

Each Apostle has his traditional and identifying symbol, and the flame of the Holy Spirit at his forehead, across the base, Saint James Minor, Saint Simon, Saint Jude and Saint Matthias; the central tier, - Saint Philip, Saint Thomas, Saint Bartholomew, and Saint Matthew; - and across the top, Saint Peter, Saint James Major, Saint John the Evangelist, and Saint Andrew.

In the central tracery member is the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit, surrounded by the stars of heavenly steadfastness.
