They would like the rose window like the Del Monte Circle, but to have the Lamb of God in the Center, like the Western Springs.

Window to be not such an intense blue as the Del Monte Kodachrome suggests.

We have now completed our study of the design for your rose window in the First Parish Congregational Church in Alfred, and are sending you the color sketch herewith.

As planned, it is based on a design somewhat similar to the one you liked in the Church at Del Monte, but is a more balanced palette, with less emphasis on the blue.

The central symbol represents the traditional Lamb of God.
