General Information These are to be just symbols of Saint Peter and Saint
Andrew - perhaps have the principal symbols of the Keys for Saint Peter and
the diagonal cross for Andrew, and perhaps have one or two secondary symbols
of his in the field - the net, etc. Have a little suggestion of canopy -
fairly simple rectangular background with some sort of light pattern on it.

The two small west windows are decorated in simple ornamental pattern, - grisaille and diaper, - accented by colorful symbols of Saints Peter and Andrew, - the keys of Peter, and the diagonal cross of Andrew.
