General Information The Four Major Archangels. \*

Note: These windows are hinged, opening out on the side. On the opposite side of the hinge there is a metal lock that protrudes out behind the casement. Plan the design in such a way that the protruding lock will not interfere with their appearance. Plan the design so that no important feature comes at that point. (The handles are on the middle, horizontally and vertically. They do not project very far.)

S. 1/6 \*Michael, Captain of the Hosts of Heaven; Gabriel, Messenger of peace and glad tidings; Raphael, the guardian angel; and Uriel, Regent of the sun.
