General Information Introduce symbols of the book and the lamp. (Lamp as in Denison, and book as in Providence, Trinity, - both in oval like the book rather than the lamp.

Design to be in harmony with the other windows - should be very carefully textured in an all-over patterning to best take care of the illumination and help distribute it.

We have now completed the design for the panels over the door, and are sending you the color sketch herewith.

We feel that the plan and subject-material has worked out beautifully. We have kept it light and brilliant in recognition of the artificial lighting, so that a reasonable amount of illumination should bring out the brilliance and clarity of the colors.

The borders are designed in the grapevine motif, harmonizing with the window we are now making; and, as planned, the symbols represent the open book and the lamp. — Right

We are confident that with the correct lighting, these windows will take their place very effectively.
